- 1. Meeting started at 10:33 a.m.
- 2. Adidas Mediation. The mediation will take place on June 13-14 in Los Angeles. Brian has been working closely with the state Department of Justice to prepare for it. Brian and Darrell Bazzell will represent the UW in the mediation. The committee had some hypothetical questions for Brian and Darrell and the committee decided to meet again on June 20 at 1 p.m. to discuss the mediation outcome.
- 3. Designated Supplier Program. The committee discussed the DSP power point program produced by the Worker Rights Consortium and presented at the WRC Caucus on May 1 in Washington, DC. Dawn Crim and Cindy Van Matre both attended the Caucus.

While the DOJ approves universities having worked together to develop the DSP standards, Scott Nova of the WRC stressed that universities should make independent business decisions – including whether, when and which licensees, to implement the DSP – without coordinating with other schools. The WRC staff will be providing DSP-related information to its members in the near future. Meanwhile, Cindy will start discussions with Collegiate Licensing Company staff on ways to feasibly incorporate DSP concepts into the Wisconsin licensing program.
